



Energy and Facility Renewal Program

The Town of Placentia is pleased to announce that we have embarked on Energy and Facility Renewal Program with Honeywell, our energy services partner selected through a Council approved RFP process. The program will focus on identifying opportunities to upgrade our building infrastructure, conserve energy, reduce operating costs and lower environmental emissions; all contributing to an improved environment for our staff and facility users.

The first phase of the program involves an assessment of the Town's building infrastructure which includes validating the current conditions. Systems such as heating, ventilation, air conditioning, mechanical equipment and lighting will be the main areas of focus. Honeywell auditors will begin reviews the week of July 10, 2017. We do not expect any interruptions to our regular operations during the audit phase.

Once the initial assessment is complete, Honeywell and the Town of Placentia will jointly select the upgrades that align with our energy, sustainability and other facilities goals. The scope of work selected will be aimed at revitalizing the Town's infrastructure while permanently reducing electrical consumption and operating costs, as well as lowering our environmental footprint.

We are excited to be starting the first phase of the program. Upgrading our infrastructure, greening our facilities and improving our energy efficiency are important to us. The program with Honeywell will support these initiatives over the long term and allow us to demonstrate our environmental stewardship to the community.
