Mayor Pearson called the meeting to order at 7:08 p.m.

Municipal Awareness Week was May 5<sup>th</sup> – May 11<sup>th</sup>. Municipal government is responsible for the provision of services that enhance the quality of life of its citizens. Dedicated mayors, councillors and staff are essential for the effective governance of their municipalities and to recognize and encourage the contribution of all who work diligently for the improvement of work and dedication. In reflection of Municipal Awareness Week, the grade 6 students from St. Anne's visited the Town Hall on May 15<sup>th</sup> and took part in a mock Council election which was enjoyed by all.

National Nursing Week was May  $6^{th}$  – May  $12^{th}$ . The theme this year, "Changing Lives.
