Responsibilities

- Assist with minor repairs and upkeep of recreational facilities and infrastructure.
- Perform routine inspections of facilities and infrastructure.
- Provide labour support as needed.
- Operate and maintain various equipment and tools, including ride-on lawnmowers, landscaping equipment/tools.
- Assist with special events as required.
- Adhere to safety guidelines and procedures to ensure a safe working environment.

Requirements

- Must possess a valid Newfoundland & Labrador Class 5 driver's license.
- Strong physical stamina and the ability to perform labor-intensive tasks.
- Ability to lift 50+ lbs.
- Ability to work in inclement weather to ensure facilities are well maintained.
- Previous experience in a similar role; operating ride-on lawn mover and use of landscaping equipment.
- Proficient in operating and maintaining equipment; capable of loading and driving a light pickup with trailer attachment for transporting mower/equipment.
