Successful candidates must demonstrate reliability, adaptability, and a strong understanding of safety procedures within a construction or public works setting.

Position Requirements

- High School Diploma or GED (preferred)
- Minimum of 2 years' experience in the construction industry or labour duties (preferred)
- Basic understanding of construction principles and workplace procedures
- Landscaping experience considered an asset
- Ability to work in high-stress and varying weather conditions
- Must possess a valid Newfoundland and Labrador driver's license

Key Duties & Responsibilities

- Lift and carry up to 50 lbs; navigate uneven terrain and active construction sites
- Perform site preparation and cleanup for construction projects
- Street sweeping and road surface cleaning
- General maintenance of town properties, roads, and public areas
- Set up and dismantle equipment or signage as required
- Direct traffic to ensure the safety of pedestrians, motorists, and work crews
- Operate or assist with operation of light construction tools and equipment
- Perform roadside brush cutting and vegetation control along public roadways
- Conduct asphalt and sidewalk repairs
- Maintain and inspect public works equipment and vehicles
- Perform other duties as assigned by supervisory personnel
