This is a limited call for quotes to:

- > Remove existing fencing and dispose of damaged material as per provincial guidelines.
- > Stabilize groundwork following removal to ensure the integrity for new fence installation.
- > Supply and install a Type 1, Class A medium style fence
 - √ 9 gauge chain link fencing
 - √ 135 m long
 - √ 1.2 m high
 - ✓ New fence posts to be installed in concrete extending 50 mm above ground level
 - Posts at beginning of fence and then placed 3 m apart with final post at the end of the fence
 - Posts to be at a depth of 1200 m X 300m diameter and extend 50mm above ground level – sloped to drain and secured in concrete.
 - Complete with end caps
- Contractors are to reuse undamaged existing posts, top rail and fittings where feasible.
- Contractors will supply new posts where required; corner posts are to be 4" in diameter; remaining post size is to be per industry standard.
- Contractors will supply and install all new posts, top rail, fittings and mesh as required.
- > All materials are to be galvanized.
