IMPORTANT REMINDERS

-All waste must be ready for pick up by 7:00am the morning of collection. Please ensure waste is covered.

-There is a **6 bag limit** on household waste. Recycling bags are unlimited.

-If recycling containers and cardboard are mixed, they will be considered contaminated. These contaminated bags will count towards your **6 bag limit** on household waste.

-Waste collection areas must be entirely free and clear from snow and hornets/wasp nests. If this is not adhered to, waste will not be picked up
